



#### CHAPTER XI

TO AMEND AND AND AND AND CHAPTER XI. PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS AND RECREATION AREAS OF "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH HANOVER".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of North Hanover, in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey as follows:

## SECTION 11.1 APPLICATION OF ORDINANCE.

The rules and regulations promulgated herein shall apply to all public parks, playgrounds and recreational areas.

#### SECTION 13.2 REGULATIONS.

The Township Committee may, from time to time, by Resolution adopt such regulations as it may choose to facilitate the effective operation and control of all parks, playgrounds and recreation areas under its jurisdiction.

#### SECTION 11.3 PROHIBITED ACTS.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person on township property as contemplated by Section 11.1 hereof to:
- (1) Use threatening, abusive or insulting language.
  - (2) Do any obscene or indecent act.
  - (3) Throw stones or other missiles.
  - (4) Annoy persons.
- (5) Interfere with, encumber, obstruct or render dangerous any public way, path, walk, bridge or public place.
- (6) Do any act tending or amounting to a breach of the peace.
- (7) Climb or stand upon any fence, shelter, seat, bridge railing or support, statue or other erection.
- (8) Introduce, carry or fire any firecrackers, torpedoes or fireworks.
- (9) Engage in, instigate, aid or encourage a contention or fight.
  - (10) Assault any person.

- (11) Participate in betting, gambling, gaming or use or operate any slot machine or gaming table or other gambling instrument or sell fortunes.
- (12) Solicit gifts or contributions for any purpose without permission of the Township Committee.
- (13) Possess or consume alcoholic beverages without permission of the Township Committee.
- (14) Be under the influence of intextcating alcoholic beverages.
- (15) Possess, use or be under the influence of drugs as defined and prohibited by Title 24 of the New Jersey Revised Statutes.
- (16) Give entertainment of any kind or transact business of any kind or hold public meetings or assemblies without permission of the Township Committee.
- (17) Occupy a camp or campground or sleep overnight without permission of the Township Committee.
- [18] .Sell, vend or give away any articles of merchandise or other matter or distribute handbills or circulars without permission of the Township Committee.
- (19) Kindle, build, maintain or use a fire except in fireplaces provided or in an approved container.
- (20) Post, paint or affix or erect any sign, advertisement, banner or any other matter for attracting attention without permission of the Township Committee.
- (21) Possess or use guns, knives, slingshots or other dangerous weapons.
- (22) Possess or use any explosive material that may cause an explosion when used either alone or in combination with some other material to produce rapid flaming combustion or administer a destructive blow to surrounding objects.
- (23) Kill, injure or disturb any animal or bird or damage any grass, tree, shrub or plant or any building, sign structure or equipment upon any premises under the jurisdiction of the township.
- (24) Ride, drive or bring any horse upon any township property as contemplated by Section 11.1 hereof.

- (25) No Pets of any kind allowed.
- (26) Drive or park any motor vehicles,

including minibikes, snowmobiles or other power-driven equipment, on township property as contemplated by Section 11.1 hereof without permission of the Township Committee. Township maintenance vehicles and those of township officials and employees and emergency vehicles shall be permitted.

(27) Swim, wada or otherwise go into any body of water within the parks, playgrounds and recreational areas of the Township of North Hanover except in accordance with the rules and regulations relating to the use thereof. No power-driven, or radio controlled, boats, aeroplanes or other devices, of any type shall be permitted within the parks, playgrounds and recreational areas.

(28) No Bicycles shall be allowed on any play

area.

- (29) No roller skates, skate boards, or other wheel toys shall be allowed on Tennis Courts, Shuffle Courts or Basketball Courts.
- (30) No individuals shall use Tennis Courts, Basketball Courts, or Shuffle Courts for a period of more than one (1) hour continuously.
- (31) Ice Hockey and open skating shall be at the discretion of the Recreation Committee.

#### SECTION 11.4 MINORS.

No parent, guardian or custodian of any minor shall permit or allow said minor to do any act prohibited by this Ordinance. Said parent, guardian or custodian shall be held liable for any such acts.

## SECTION 11.5 PERMITS FOR SPECIAL USE; FEES,

- A. Organizations desiring to use park facilities on a group basis will make applications, in writing, to the Municipal Clerk, thirty (30) days prior to the date desired. Applications shall be available at the North Hanover Township Municipal Building.
- B. Organizations utilizing facilities are responsible for the care of equipment and grounds utilized and the cleaning of the area at the completion of the event.
- C. Organizations utilizing park areas must present proof of liability insurance, covering injuries to participants during the period the facility is being used, in amounts as determined by the Township Committee based upon probable risk,
- D. Organizations utilizing park areas will be responsible for the coordinantion of traffic control and parking with the Township Police Department.

E. The Township Committee shall have the right to refuse or cancel the use of any facility to organizations or individuals for reason of repair, construction or other reasons that may be detrimental to the care and upkeep of the area.

f. The use of alcoholic beverages by an organization may be permitted by the Township Committee in the park areas.

G. The use of posted baseball fields will be by permit issued by the Foundative.

## SECTION 11.6 ENFORCEMENT.

The provisions, prohibitions and requirements of this Ordinance shall be enforceable by state and township police and supervisory personnel designated by the Township Committee.

#### SECTION 11.7 REPEALER.

The provisions of this Ordinance are in addition to and not in repeal of, except where inconsistent herewith, otherwise applicable requirements, prohibitions and provisions of law.

#### SECTION 11.8 SEVERABILITY.

The provisions hereof shall be deemed severable.

In the event any such provision shall be held invalid, the remaining provisions shall nevertheless be deemed to remain in full force and effect.

## SECTION 11.9 VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment for not more than thirty (\$500.00) days in the discretion of the Municipal Judge.

## SECTION 11.10 WHEN EFFECTIVE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its final passage and publication as provided by law.
