

North Hanover Recreation Advisory Committee

Nancy Mannuccia Called the meeting to order, stated this is an advisory committee that makes recommendations to the twp committee about recreation and community building activities for the township residents.

Committee Reports

Basketball- No Report. Darren confirmed that he'd reminded CBLamb that Adult Volleyball is beginning 1/8/14 and they responded that setting up between practices and volleyball might be an issue. Darlene clarified that it was a misunderstanding and there is no change from the past 3 years of adult volleyball, the building will be vacated by 9:30PM

Baseball: John reported a question was raised as to what account the fence replacement would be disbursed from and Bill Quackenboss is looking into it.

John reported on Registration Fees: NBIAA 12/18/13 meeting \$118 per baseball player for regionalized (3rd grade, 9yrs old and older), ref's are paid \$55 per game. The NBIAA will charge us \$105 per player for the 2014 season, we discussed increasing our registration fees but decided to leave them as they are: Non-resident out of town registrants must register directly on the NBIAA site and we will not be subsidizing them. Our registration fee for non-regionalized sports is \$70, through rookie, we will accept out of town registrations up to rookie, after that we have no rec program and they must go regional.

Recreation program (non-regionalized) Basketball is through 6th grade and soccer is through 8th grade. We considered raising the fee from \$30 to \$35 to cover the administrative fee for online registrations and reviewed number of players and costs.

Greg made the following *motion: Let us keep the North Hanover resident registration fee for all regionalized sports \$30.* Second: Ron DeBaecke, Vote: All ayes, motion carried.

John made the following *motion: North Hanover will not subsidize any non-resident registration for any regionalized sport. Non resident non-North Hanover residents must register directly through NBIAA registration process and pay NBIAA directly and in full.* Second: Greg Byles, Vote; all ayes, motion carried.

John drafted the email for Open baseball/softball registration, that ends 1/31/14
Twan suggests the registration form is removed from the website to discourage paper registration. He is available Monday nights at town hall for people to walk-in and register on the computer, computers are available at the library as well if people do not have internet access at their home.

Community Events: Darlene confirmed the committee's decision to buy 70 tickets in section 107 for the opening game of the Trenton Freedom March 30, 2104. Total cost will be \$1512 if all are sold, 25% deposit now due. We will sell the first 70 tickets at \$12 , any others at cost \$21.60 (\$24, discount 20%=\$21.60)

The Blue Claws game 6/24/14 deposit now due, reserving 100 tickets and we will charge \$15 for adults, \$7 for juniors (10 and under) Our cost: adults \$24.95 5-12 yrs of age \$16.95

She will send out sponsor letters very soon. Signs were left up over the winter and that was intentional. There is no change to the cost of sponsorship.

The fence that was damaged during the construction of the new building should be reported and the contractor pursued for restoration.

Twan made a motion to adjourn, Joe Tartaglia second, all ayes
