Chairman's report:

- ◆John received an inquiry from Mr. Zrilli regarding the possibility of leasing the snack facility to a private enterprise to operate a snack service from the building at Green Acres.
- ◆Darlene has reserved the Volleyball dates at the Gym
- ◆Darlene has arranged for teachers to lead carols at the lighting and for Pastor of the Rose of Sharon church to say a few words
- ◆Blue Claws baseball night will be a Saturday in June

Basketball Report: Darren reported Pictures are set for 1/5/15.

- ◆The program is up and running despite lower enrollment. ◆Scheduling of game space is in the process, by Paul, UES is not available for game use. Only the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade North Hanover teams have access to the gym there. He has turned in a requisition for tee shirts.
- ◆The major girls were in need of a coach until the last moment.
- ◆He asked how we keep track of the background checks, concussion and Rutgers Coach certificates. Brief discussion followed in which John said he would look through his files and find out the process whereby people can look up and re-print their certifications. He or Twan will build it into our database. The Police keep track of the background checks it is up to us to provide the names of the volunteers to the Chief.

Soccer Report: Twan reported his wish list: small size goal (7x21) approx. \$3350, spray paint (approx. \$107 per box), a full size goal (approx. \$3500), both to replace the goal posts with the square posts. Discussion about these needs led to a

- ◆He also reported that the Midlands tournament is has no cost to the township and does not use the township equipment or supplies. This year during the tournament the Rec advisory committee received a \$200 donation from R. Zrilli

Registration Report: Twan requested the list of players and coaches and coach assistants from Darren. One uniform deposit was sent out. One person claimed not to have been contacted for a team after registering and paying within the time frame.
