Four more people will form a full committee, recruitment necessary.

No members of the public were present. The minutes of the December 4 meeting were approved.

John spoke of the project work-up he created (Exhibit A) as a vision of the way the Recreation section of the township website could be organized and how it would work. The committee suggested that the injury form, emergency contact form, a comment section, and info about the fee and schedule for coach certification might be added. Commissioners were interested to know if Registration and Community Events could have individual emails.

Twan added that he is doing a trial run of the new registration program before it goes live.

John presented the calendar for this year- and made a motion that: we will continue with the first Tuesday of the month beginning at 7:30 and completing our work by 9:30PM, the April meeting will be during school break and will not be rescheduled, the November meeting that is election day will be moved to Wednesday 11/6/13. The motion was second by Greg and carried with complete consent.

John made a motion to invite Ron deBaecke to be a committee member after having stated his interest. Second by Darlene, motion carried.

Ed Klusman and Harry Applegate and John Connor (baseball maybe) will also be invited.

NBIAA has their own registration website, they want all regionalized players to use it. Visitors are asked to pay on the site- rates as follows: Basketball \$100, Softball/Baseball \$90, Babe Ruth: \$185 If North Hanover players register and pay on site thru their credit card. If a player registers on North Hanover paper they will pay \$30 because the township subsidizes it. Everyone is charged the same amount by NBIAA but North Hanover pays after the season not up front, this way we are getting an itemization of what the township is charged. They would like us to pay in advance of the season, but we really can't pay for services in advance of their rendering by local government law. We expect the league to accept North Hanover registrations on line with a 100% discount, and we will continue to pay for all our registered players.

Someone questioned the cost and scheduling of the batting facility, it is a separate entity from the NBIAA. Assessments will be held in the building. No one knew how the cost was calculated.

Twan asked if the new building could be winterized to protect it from freezing up. He also noted the fence is very bad: \$5,000 62 sections, 72 posts the posts should be

cemented in and suggested white vinyl in place of the wooden split rail. The chain link needs repair as well, it is 6' high.

Basketball awards are set.

John reviewed the snack shack want list estimated at between \$6,000 and \$7,500 Twan made a motion to adjourn the meeting, second John.
