STICKERS MUST BE DISPLAYED.

Only residents of North Hanover may use this facility. Any non-resident, commercial entity or resident caught using this facility improperly will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law. Any misuse should be reported to the waste facility Commissioner, Lou De Lorenzo by calling 609-758-2522 Ext. 241.

All Residents are required to bring their brush, leaves & Christmas trees to Herman's Landscaping Supply located at 181 Jacobstown-Cookstown Road. Their phone number is 609-758-3808. Hours of operation are Mon-Fri 7:00 am to 5:00 pm and Sat. from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. Residents are required to hold an annual waste permit sticker to drop off at this location.

Township residents can purchase an annual sticker for \$70. (There is a \$10 late fee beginning February 1.) This permits residents to utilize the Township's trash compacting service for all standard household rubbish.

The Township Committee is committed to finding new ways to enhance services while being fiscally prudent.

**STORMWATER MANAGEMENT AND
GRASS CLIPPINGS**

It is important to note that grass clippings can no longer be accepted at any township location for disposal. County and State Environmental Inspectors have advised that the Township cease the collection of grass clippings. This is pursuant to New Jersey State Stormwater Management Regulations; it is recommended that residents compost their grass clippings.

Homeowners and commercial groundskeepers need to keep grass clipping from the streets, driveways and other paved areas where they can wash away with stormwater runoff. Grass clippings that fall on paved areas should be swept.

Why are grass clippings harmful to stormwater?

Yard waste contributes nutrients, such as nitrogen and phosphorous, which cause unwanted and uncontrolled growth of algae and aquatic weeds. Grass Clippings also clog storm sewer drains which contribute to flooding.
