TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES  
December 4, 2014, 7:00 P.M.**

**CALL TO ORDER:** Mayor Quackenboss called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**SUNSHINE STATEMENT:** “The provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act have been met. Notice of this meeting has been transmitted by email to the Bordentown Register News, Burlington County Times and The Trenton Times as well as given to those having requested same and posted on the Township bulletin board located in the foyer of the municipal building”.

**OPEN PUBLIC COMMENT**

Mayor Quackenboss opened the meeting to the public.

Ralph Laks, 487 Cedar Road, Lakewood, stated that he was just following-up on a letter he had sent to the Committee with regards to continued support for his solar farm. He questioned if the Township decided to vote in the affirmative vote, he asked what the procedure would be. Mayor Quackenboss stated that this matter is scheduled under discussion.

Gia Seron, 715 Province Line Road, has concerns regarding the intersection of Province Line, Ellisdale and Hill Road. She indicated that this is a very dangerous intersection and would like to see additional stop signs or traffic controls located at this intersection. She indicated that the houses are located really close to the road. She had had her fence, mailboxes, etc. ran into. She provided benefits to a four way stop. She stated that it is wonderful that there is a female police officer who does sit at the Church. Mayor Quackenboss requested that Chief Keubler do a study on it. Chief Keubler stated that part of the problem is that the area is a concurrent jurisdiction with Upper Freehold. Chief Keubler stated that several corner houses in that intersection has allowed their vegetation grow that tends to block that intersection.

John Kocubinski, 950 Province Line Road stated he has questions regarding the New Jersey Natural Gas comments made at the last meeting. The minutes of the meeting in September stated that this project was going to happen. He stated that this would be a big impact. He asked where the project was at in its progress.

Mayor Quackenboss stated the meetings that took place were that the gas company approached us indicating that they had an interest in putting lines within our town. The Deputy Mayor had

met with them twice. The project is in its preliminary stages. The company will be brought in for a public meeting.

Mr. Kocubinski stated that the minutes stated that “they are” going to install gas lines.

Deputy Mayor Durr stated that he was contact by the Township Clerk that these people wished to meet. The meeting was informational. Comments were made at these meeting by them that our residents may wonder what is going on because they were out surveying. They wanted to Committee to preliminary know what was going on. He did preliminary ask what would benefit North Hanover Township. Deputy Mayor stated that nothing will be done without input from the Township, the Township’s attorney, etc. At the last meeting Deputy Mayor Durr indicated that the company provided a proposed route. It might happen it might not happen.

Committeeman Moscatiello stated that this is very common for the Township to be approached on such projects. He stated that he also has concerns.

Mr. Kocubinski again reiterated his recommendation to improve transparency.

Jim Sadlier, 129 Schoolhouse Road, expressed his concern about the article in the Burlington County Times about no one from the Township Committee attending the Veterans Day Ceremony. He questioned if any of the members of the Committee are Veterans.

Mayor Quackenboss stated that he did receive the invitation. He stated that he was called out of state several days prior to the ceremony by his employer. He had planned attending. He did try to have Committeeman Moscatiello attend on his behalf, but unfortunately he had to work as well.

Committeewoman Butler stated that the Township did have a representative, Paul Reuter, who is a Vietnam Veteran attend on their behalf. He did attend on behalf of the Township Committee and there was a wreath that he was to present; however, something occurred that did not allow him to bring the wreath into the ceremony.

Committeeman Delorenzo stated that he takes great offense to the op-ed that was in the Burlington County Times. He stated that his brother died in Vietnam. He spends that day with his mother visiting his brother’s grave.

Mr. Sadlier explained that he took offense to the article as well. He explained his family history, as well as his history in serving his country.

Committeeman Moscatiello stated that his father died was a World War II Veteran. Veterans Day he works. He attends the ceremony on Memorial Day. Committee Moscatiello stated that the person who wrote the op-ed attending the meeting indicating that North Hanover Township is the first Purple Heart community in New Jersey. This was brought before the Committee by a Vietnam Veteran. The Committee has great respect for the military. We are currently working with that person to put the Purple Heart Community on every sign. He is offended that they are being judged for a moment of time, without having the courtesy of being asked.

Mr. Sadlier stated that he is satisfied that the Committees hearts and souls are with the military. The Committee thanked him for his service.

**ENGINEER'S REPORT**

Justin Gibson stated that the capital road program is scheduled for discussion later this evening. He is awaiting further notice regarding the 2014 Burlington County Road Overlay Program. The Board of County Freeholders awarded the Township \$60,000 under the FY Burlington County Municipal Park Development program. The scope of work is being revised to utilize these grant funds. We are awaiting notification from the NJDOT regarding the FY 2015 NJDOT State Aid Application. Quotes are being received on Friday, December 12 for the Orr Road culvert project.

Work has been completed for the Jacobstown-Arneytown Road (Phase II) project. The initial 75% has been submitted to the State for reimbursement of \$103,425. He is working with the contractor to close out the project.

Deputy Mayor Durr stated that there was a flooding problem before the overlay, and now it seems to be worse.

Mr. Gibson stated that the contractor has been notified and to alleviate the problem.

**DISCUSSION**

- Discontinuing Salt Service for the North Hanover School District

Mayor Quackenboss stated that he and the Deputy Mayor met with the school representatives to discuss their use of the salt. They both left the meeting satisfied that they are accurately tracking the use of the salt. All concerns regarding lack of payment and use have been satisfied.

Deputy Mayor Durr stated that with the concerns of this Committee he was directed to meet with the school. The concerns were whether or not the Township was being compensated for the salt the school was using, whether or not we knew how much salt the school was using and whether or not the school knew how much salt they were using. The school has provided very comprehensive records on the use of salt. The school has calibrated the trucks they use for the salt. The only change is that they will be submitting their paperwork every month. They feel their concerns were addressed.

- Funding of Street Maintenance Plan (continuation)

This has been discussed for several meetings. He believes the Committee is in agreement that they would like to get all the roads done in a fiscally responsible manner. There were

discussions and calculations were provided for payment for a one year project, two year project or a three year project. He did express his concerns regarding the financial impact in doing a one year project. Mayor Quackenboss stated that he wished to do a straw poll on the project term. Committeeman Delorenzo voted for a one year project term. Committeewoman Butler, Committeeman Moscatiello, Deputy Mayor Durr and Mayor Quackenboss all voted for a two year project term. Committeeman Moscatiello requested that any formal action be held until January to see what the financial state the Township is in after the end of this year. All Committee members agreed.

- Request for a Letter for Continuing Support for the Laks Solar Farm

Mayor Quackenboss stated a letter has been received requesting the Township's continued support for the Laks Solar Farm. This project has already been approved by the Joint Land Use Board. Deputy Mayor Durr provided the history of the project as well as the requirements in order to construct this type of project. It was unanimous vote of the Committee to write a continuing support letter. Municipal Clerk Dye was directed to construct the letter with the Township Attorney review and approval. Mr. Laks indicated that the letter needs to be received and submitted by December 10.

- Appreciation Dinner

Committeewoman Butler stated that the Municipal Clerk informed her that the place where the Appreciation Dinner is held will be closed due to renovations in January and February. She indicated that we would have to hold the dinner in another location or wait until March. After a brief discussion, it was determined that both Committeewoman Butler and Committeeman Moscatiello would consult with each other and make some phone calls to see if another place could be secured for January. If a place cannot be secured than we would schedule it for March.

### **TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE "COMMENTS"**

Committeeman Delorenzo stated that he has made his comments regarding the ridiculous op-ed in the Burlington County Times.

Deputy Mayor Durr stated that he has not spoken about the op-ed article; mostly because he is not a Veteran. He stated that he supports and appreciates anyone who wears a uniform for our country. He provided his history with family members being in the service. He is saddened that Veterans issues are used politically.

Committeeman Moscatiello stated that he was deeply upset with the op-ed. He told his history of his family members being in the service. He stated that he appreciates every Veteran.

Committeeman Moscatiello stated that a few weeks ago he was in the Green Acres Park. He expressed how proud he was of that Park.

Mayor Quackenboss expressed his option regarding the op-ed in the Burlington Township. He asked to spread the word about how much this Committee respects our Veterans.

Mayor Quackenboss stated that he received an invitation for the Committee for the Senior Luncheon on December 16 at the Bowers Building.
