2015-43 Resolution Endorsing the Submission of the 2014 Recycling Tonnage Grant Application

RESOLUTION 2015-43

TOWNSHIP OF NORTH HANOVER  
COUNTY OF BURLINGTON

**ENDORING THE SUBMISSION OF THE 2014 RECYCLING  
TONNAGE GRANT APPLICATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L.1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grant may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expand existing programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has promulgated recycling regulations to Implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for the **2014 Recycling Tonnage Grant** will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of the Township Committee of North Hanover Township to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of North Hanover Township that North Hanover Township hereby endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Cindy Dye of North Hanover Township to ensure that the application is properly filed, and hereby appoints Richard Parks of Eastampton Township as the Certified Recycling Coordinator to review and execute the 2014 Recycling Tonnage Report on behalf of North Hanover Township; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.

**DISCUSSION ITEM**

- 2015 Municipal Budget

Mayor Durr stated that he met with the Township’s CFO to make some adjustments to the budget, which is outlined in Mr. Bruno’s memo dated April 2. The changes requested in the budget were able to be accommodated without any tax increase. There will be a tax rate increase of approximately \$.04 for the road program. The Township Committee discussed the changes as recommended by Mayor Durr.

Motion made by Committeewoman Butler and seconded by Deputy Mayor Delorenzo to proceed as recommend in the memo. All were in favor.

Mayor Durr stated that the budget is planned to be introduced on April 16.

**TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE “COMMENTS”**

Committeeman Quackenboss stated that the Township Clerk received a phone call from the engineer working on the pipeline project, inviting Township representatives to attend a meeting regarding potential traffic issues with the project. She then received a phone call uninviting

Township representatives stating that the County does not wish to have the municipalities at that meeting.

Committeeman Quackenboss stated that New Jersey Natural Gas did file their petition with the Board of Public Utility today. In speaking with the representative, they are still looking to hold an open house and requested that he provide a contact for the school. Committeeman Quackenboss also stated that he has reached out to the County Freeholders and spoke to their representative regarding the pipeline. He stated that Upper Freehold passed a resolution stating that it would not allow the pipeline to go through its town.

Committeewoman Butler stated that she spoke to Justin regarding the park grant. They are reviewing the options.

Deputy Mayor Delorenzo stated that he was at the meeting with the pipeline with Committeeman Quackenboss. He reported about that meeting. He did stress that New Jersey Natural Gas has to have a public hearing before the BPU. He stressed that this would be the time for the residents to come out and voice their concerns.

Mayor Durr stated that Alex Robotin, Chesterfield Township Committeeman, was present and he welcomed him.
