
On behalf of New Jersey Natural Gas (NJNG), this letter serves as notification that a flood hazard area fact-finding meeting and CAFRA public hearing will be held on September 7, 2016 at 6 pm at the Ramada Inn, 1083 US-206, Bordentown, New Jersey.

NJNG has submitted an application for approval to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) under the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act (N.J.A.C. 7:7A), Flood Hazard Area Control Act (N.J.A.C. 7:13) and the Coastal Permit Program Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:7) for the proposed Southern Reliability Link Project. The permit will authorize NJNG to conduct regulated activities within NJNG's proposed Project Area located in the six municipalities listed above. A copy of this application describing the proposed project was sent to your office on June 26, 2015. Enclosed, please find an updated set of the project permits plans to be retained by your office for public review.
