# North Hanover Affordability Assistance Policies and Procedures Manual

Polices & Procedures Manual

#### Introduction

The Township of North Hanover has dedicated funding from its Affordable Housing Trust Fund to operate this Affordability Assistance Program. Trust funds come from Development Fees levied upon developers in accordance with the Township's Development Fee Ordinance, and may also come from a payment in lieu of construction of affordable units for a specific development project as approved by the Superior Court. The creation of this Affordability Assistance program is designed to help implement the Township's chosen program areas.

The purpose of this Manual is to describe the policies and procedures of the Affordability Assistance Program. This Manual describes the basic content and operation of the affordable assistance program components. It has been prepared with a flexible format allowing for periodic updates, when required, due to revisions in regulations, terms, and/or procedures.

Where it is found that a new procedure may be more effective or can eliminate a recurring problem, that procedure may be incorporated into the program operation by amending this Operating Manual. In addition, this manual may be periodically revised to reflect changes in local, state, and federal policies and regulations relative to implementation of the affordable housing programs described herein.

#### Types of Affordability Assistance

There are two options of affordability assistance listed below. The specifics of both are summarized in Exhibit 1. No ongoing or monthly assistance options are currently available.

- 1. **Rental Assistance**. It is the township's preference to offer affordability assistance in such a manner as to reduce costs for renters of the unit through one of two options for rental assistance:
  - Security Deposit Assistance: Rental applicants who display a need for funds for the security deposit requirements at any of the three affordable rental complexes may apply for funds to cover that requirement. In addition, assistance for rentals would achieve its objective of rendering units more affordable for moderate, low, and very low rentals.
  - First Month's Rental Payment Program: If it is the rental complex's preference, funds may instead be used to pay the first month's rent to lower the initial expenses of signing a lease for an affordable housing unit.
- 2. Rental Complex Rehabilitation Assistance Fund. If the need arises due to an emergency situation or due to weather related incidents, the rental complexes may apply to the Township for rehabilitation funds derived from the affordability assistance fund. As the rental complexes are comprised of only deed-restricted affordable housing units, funds may be used to rehabilitate units or common areas, including such things as providing generators or mechanical upgrades as required.

#### **Eligibility**

Applications (see Exhibit 1) submitted for affordability assistance (First Month's Rent and Security Deposit Assistance) will be provided on a first come-first-served basis according to the following criteria:

- 1. There are affordability assistance funds remaining in the budget for the year.
- 2. The applicant is currently in the process renting or rents a deed restricted affordable unit in North Hanover Township as their primary residence.
- 3. The applicant has not received an affordability assistance grant in the past. (Only one award per household is permitted. This requirement can be waived with justification.)
- 4. The end user household must be income certified.

#### **Repayment Terms**

The First Months' Rent Program, Security Deposit Assistance and Rental Complex Rehabilitation Fund programs are grants and there is no repayment agreement.

#### ADMINISTRATION

The Administrative Agent will be responsible for administering the Affordability Assistance Programs. Questions about these programs should be directed to the Administrative Agent, included on the next page. #### First Month's Rent/Security Deposit Program

- 1. Applicant submits application.
- 2. CGP&H reviews and processes application.
- 3. CGP&H notifies Township and prepares resolution authorizing grant.
- 4. Township adopts Resolution.
- 5. Township sends assistance directly to landlord.
- 6. CGP&H records assistance on master reporting spreadsheet.

#### Rental Complex Rehabilitation Fund

- 1. Applicant submits a statement of necessary repairs and cost estimates.
- 2. CGP&H reviews and processes application.
- 3. Applicant selects Contractor and signs contract with contractor.
- 4. All necessary permits are filed with the township and the work is completed.
- 5. Township inspects and approves the work is completed.
- 6. Applicant notifies CGP&H that the work has been satisfactorily completed and sends copy of completed permit.
- 7. CGP&H drafts resolution authorizing grant.
- 8. Township adopts resolution
- 9. Township issues check to the contractor.
- 10. CGP&H records assistance on master reporting spreadsheet.
