ORDINANCE – ADOPTION

An Ordinance Amending the Township Code of the Township of North Hanover by Creating Part-Time Position of the "Custodial Supervisor" and Establishing Requisite Duties,

Responsibilities and Salary for Said Position

ORDINANCE 2020-11 COUNTY OF BURLINGTON TOWNSHIP OF NORTH HANOVER

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH HANOVER BY CREATING PART TIME POSITION OF "CUSTODIAL SUPERVISOR" AND ESTABLISHING REQUISITE DUTIES, RESPONSBILITIES AND SALARY FOR SAID POSITION

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of North Hanover believes that it is in the best interest of the Municipality to create a new full-time position entitled "Custodial Supervisor"; and

WHEREAS, the Custodial Supervisor shall be responsible for the daily upkeep and maintenance of all municipal buildings and grounds and will work in conjunction with the Township's Road and Public Grounds Service Director, vendors/third party contractors utilized by the Township for snow removal and salting and grass cutting and/or other public works related contracts to ensure that the Township's buildings and grounds are being properly maintained; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee further desires to establish the duties, responsibilities, and salary range for said position.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of North Hanover as follows:

SECTION 1. The position of "Custodial Supervisor" be and hereby established as a part-time position and the rate of salary of the employee who is appointed to said position is hereby fixed in the following schedule:

TITLE PER HOUR

Custodian Supervisor

Range \$16.00 - \$22.00

SECTION 2: Duties and Responsibilities: The Custodial Supervisors shall be responsible for work involving the assignment and supervision of custodial/grounds/maintenance employees, third party contractors and/or vendors, at the case may be, who are hired or contracted with by the Township to maintain the cleanliness, sanitation and necessary repairs of Township Buildings and Grounds, including the Green Acres Schoolhouse Road Park. The Custodial Supervisor is responsible for training new employees in proper custodial/grounds procedures for the use of manually operated tools, powered tools or machinery, cleaning compounds, solvents, and chemicals. The Custodial Supervisor will also work in conjunction with the Township's Road and Public Grounds Service Director, vendors and/or third-party contractors utilized by the Township for snow removal, salting, grass cutting and/or other public works related contracts. The Custodial Supervisor shall also perform daily duties as needed in support of the departmental mission and report to the Administrative Liaison.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances inconsistent with the above are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance and the salaries herein are subject to all Federal Laws, rulings, and guidelines concerning prices and wages.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect after its final passage and publication according to law.

RESOLUTION 2020-125 TOWNSHIP OF NORTH HANOVER COUNTY OF BURLINGTON

APPLICANT'S RESOLUTION LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMERGENCY FUND (CRF) GRANT

WHEREAS, as the public health emergency associated with the COVID-19 pandemic continues, the most significant negative financial impacts faced by county and municipal governments throughout New Jersey result from extreme economic contraction, deficits in tax and fee revenues, and extraordinary increases in public safety and health and human services expenditures; and

WHEREAS, severe fiscal stress limits the ability of counties and municipalities to maintain essential services and take the steps necessary to fight COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, without substantial federal assistance, residential taxpayers would absorb the primary impact of meeting these extraordinary needs and closing any associated operating deficits; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Affairs ("DCA"), through the Division of Local Government Services ("DLGS" or "Division"), has been deemed the lead agency for the distribution of the Local Government Emergency Fund (the "LGEF" or "Program"), provided through an allocation of the State of New Jersey's CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF Funds); and

WHEREAS, counties and municipalities excluded from the federal government's direct CRF allocation plan, as well as those counties and municipalities that are currently the most impacted by COVID-19 in comparison to their available resources, are eligible for LGEF funds pursuant to a maximum distribution determined by formula; and

WHEREAS, a total of \$60 million is currently being made available under the Program, with a potential \$60 million more to be allocated; and

WHEREAS, LGEF Grants exist to support costs incurred as part of a local unit's response to COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of North Hanover in the County of Burlington, that the Township of North Hanover will apply for a LGEF Grant in the amount of \$9,536.17.

Ms. Carmichael – 610 Hanover Drive – Ms. Carmichael expressed some concerns. She stated she has an ongoing issue with her driveway apron and puddling at the end of her driveway. Mayor DeBaecke noted this was the only solution as the company would no longer be accepting Township residents as it was starting to hinder their business. He noted this was the solution to keep the services for the taxpayers. It was suggested she could take directly to the companies' yard for a fee. Ms. Carmichael noted she appreciated the low taxes.
