**Baseball**

- Season is underway
- Uniform receipts have been submitted
- We spoke about the costs related to sending players to NBIAA who register with us but play for NBIAA. It appears that there is a major financial discrepancy from covering the cost minus \$35.00 (comes from residents). We spoke about how to fix this in the future with slight changes so that it wouldn't be a sudden change for our community members.
- *Motion made by Courtney: 50% of basketball for the 2019 season would be paid by residents; 50% by township. 2020 baseball would register with the NBIAA, putting all cost on the community members. (Jamie second)*
- *Motion made by Courtney: Costs of in-town sports (baseball) would also increase for the 2020 year. Wiffle (\$35), t-ball (\$40), rookie (\$45) (Casey second)*
- Current resident cost is \$35 and NBIAA costs \$90-140 per player (depending on league/age)

**Fields**

- Pitchers mound is slanted in, the batting box is higher than field level. Unfortunately community members are unhappy with our current field conditions. There are a lot of weeds taking over the infield.
- Once the ground is harder it is stated that we will be getting new dirt. Twan has found the correct way to tend to the infield weeds and he is hoping this will be the key to helping in the maintenance of the fields.

- We will currently keep the \$35 uniform deposit due to the lack of sponsorships at this time.
- We are thinking that for the 2020 season, it will be a uniform fee - in which the players would keep the shirts.
